Student Pre-Registration Information for all CPS Schools

All student registration will be online at www.cantonschools.net under quick links "Student Registration". To register online, returning students must secure a snap code from their school. Requested documents must be returned before registration is considered complete.

Computer access will be available during these pre-registration dates at Nichols Middle School Gym:

April 24, 25 & 26 12:00 – 6:00 p.m. (Pre-K-12, New & Returning Students)

May 22, 23, & 24 12:00 – 6:00 p.m. (Pre-K-12, New & Returning Students)

Location: Nichols Middle School Gym

Parents registering returning students should bring to their child's school:

- Two (2) documents showing proof of residency* & Identification
- Money for book fines from previous year

*Residency Verification:

- CMU bill showing the LAST 30 days/Entergy bill showing LAST 30 days
- Home / car insurance with current address showing residency, automobile registration
- Mortgage deed, property tax receipt, or car tag receipt
- Home / Apartment lease agreement
- Voter precinct identification
- Filed Homestead Exemption Form
- Certified copy of filed petition for guardianship if pending and final decree when granted
- Driver's License

Parents, guardians, or caretakers registering students new to the district are requested to bring to the Central Office:

- Certified birth certificate
- Student's social security card (optional)
- Two (2) documents showing proof of residency*
- MS immunization compliance certificate**
- Address & phone number of previously attended school
- Most recent report card or transcript

*The Mississippi State Department of Health (MSDH) requires the Tdap vaccination for all students entering 7th Grade.

**All Pre-Kindergarten, Kindergarten, and 1st Grade students must have a chickenpox vaccination.
