

STUDENT CONDUCT

Attention Parents of Students in Grades 6-12

We would like to direct your attention to the following rules contained within Canton Public School District's Policy on Student Conduct:

1. Students are expected to conduct themselves in all school activities in such a manner that will promote development and not inhibit it.
2. A teaching situation that is conducive to learning must be maintained. Therefore, any student whose actions make it impossible for the teacher to devote full attention to the class will be disciplined.
3. Any student who starts a disturbance or who participates in one will be suspended from school.

The following online learning guidelines are inherently embedded within the three rules above:

1. Students may not log into the Learning Management System nor its supporting components (i.e., Zoom) and impersonate another student.
2. Students are prohibited from taking images of the online learning environment and posting them to any social media outlet.
3. Students are prohibited from giving the codes for the Learning Management System or supporting components (i.e., Zoom) to anyone other than classmates or their parents.
4. Students are prohibited from engaging in distracting behavior which includes but is not limited to playing loud music, being inappropriately dressed, having inappropriate conversations in the Chat section of the Learning Management System, and engaging in any other distracting activity.

Students who do not follow the above listed rules will be removed from the general online learning environment and placed in an isolated online learning environment for a period of anywhere from 3 days to the remainder of the semester depending on the offense.

Additionally, students who are found to be in cahoots with offending students will also be disciplined. This includes sharing or commenting on inappropriate posts and/or participating in distracting conversations in the Chat section of the Learning Management System.
